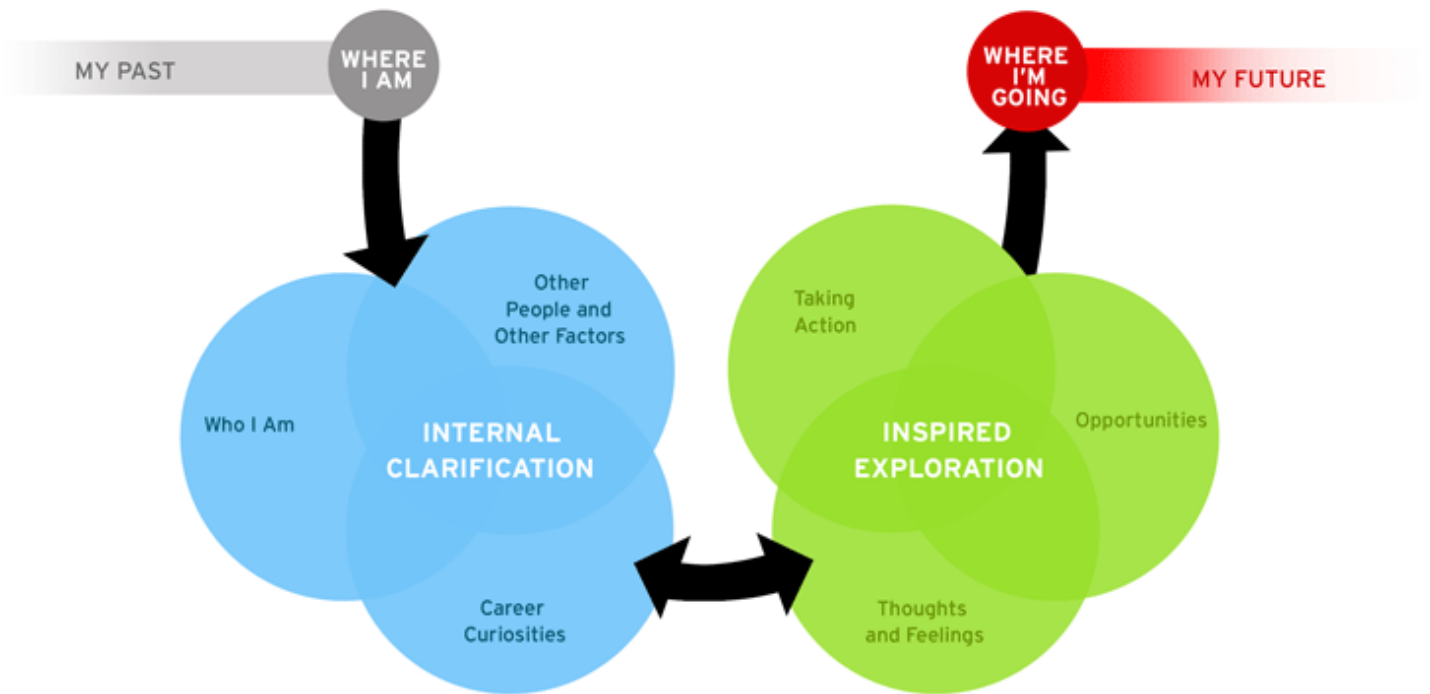


## WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY DEGREE?
